Race Rules for Demolition Derby

- 1) All Competitors and Mechanics must sign waiver of liability on the entry form. Only one entry per person. Entries are not transferable. No Refunds of entry fee.
- 2)
- 3) The Field will be limited to 60 Paid Reserve Entries on a first come first serve basis.
- 4) Driver must wear full face type helmet & **Neck Collar** with face shield, or helmet with goggles and long sleeve shirt and pants.
- 5) Driver must wear seat belt at all times during event.
- 6) Only persons who have signed the release will be allowed in the pit area.
- 7) You must use the same car in the feature that you ran in your heat.
- 8) Anyone under the influence or using alcohol or any controlled substance before or during the event will be disqualified along with the car and crew.
- 9) Any driver, car owner, or mechanic involved in any fight, demonstration, or disturbance on the track, in the pits or surrounding area before, during, or after the race shall be subject to disqualification, and forfeit any awards won.
- 10) Drivers must be 16 years old and have a valid drivers license. Drivers 16 & 17 years old will also need a notarized release signed by Parent or Guardian.
- 11) Pits will open at 2:30 p.m. and close for reserved entries at 5:30 p.m.
- 12) Paid reserves will have until 5:30 p.m. to have their vehicle inspected. Any Paid reserve that is not fully inspected by the cutoff time will forfeit his spot and entry fee.
- 13) Any openings after the cutoff time will be filled by the standby list.
- 14) There will be no buddy system, this may result in disqualification.
- 15) There will be no intentional head on collisions or hitting of driver's door.
- 16) There will be a drivers meeting approximately one half hour before the race. This meeting is mandatory for all drivers.
- 17) The derby will be composed of individual heats, and one feature
- 18) Each heat will be stopped when there are two cars left.
- 19) Do not leave your car during a heat race unless you are instructed to do so or the heat is over.
- 20) A heat winner must drive the same car in the feature that was used in the heat race.
- 21) A one-minute time limit is enforced by the track officials for restarting and making competitive contact with another car. Hit must be aggressive. Simple contact within the time limit does not constitute combat and could be considered sandbagging, which will result in disqualification.
- 22) The Fair will not be responsible for any cars, parts, or personal property before, during, or after the race.
- 23) A \$35.00 protest fee is required to contest another car. All protests must be made within 1/2 hour of the completion of event.
- 24) Officials reserve the right to reject any and all registrations. Cars decorated in poor taste will be rejected.
- 25) Flags will be used during the event
 - RED STOP RACING
 - BLACK DISQUALIFIED, Remove Flag
 - CHECKERED GO

The decision of the officials and judges are final.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1) Any standard front engine, hard top automobile or station wagon is allowed. No trucks, carryalls, Jeeps, or 4 wheel drive vehicles allowed. Station Wagons allowed Labor Day Only
- 2) Small car heats limited to 4 & 6 cylinder front wheel drives, 108" wheelbase maximum.
- 3) A maximum of 3 gallons of gas will be allowed.
- 4) Stock gas tanks must be removed. An auxiliary tank must be **securely fastened** and located behind the front seat. A fire shield must be placed between the driver and the fuel tank. the fire shield must be **securely fastened** around and completely covering the fuel tank to keep gasoline from splashing on the driver if it should get ruptured. No rubber straps for mounting
- 5) Auxiliary fuel tanks must be Portable outboard boat motor tank or Fuel cell and no larger than 6.5 gallons capacity.. All sealants used shall be dry (fully cured).
- 6) Any leakage of fuel lead to immediate disqualification. Electric fuel pump must have plainly labeled on-off switch within drivers reach and be clearly labeled unless stock electric fuel pump is wired to ignition switch
- 7) All glass and debris must be removed from car before entering fairgrounds. This includes windows, mirrors, headlights, and taillights. Windshield may be left in. A strong wire or steel mesh is recommended in windshield and drivers window area
- 8) Hood shall be secured in four places with two strands of heavy wire through each hole. No other wiring or chains to or around bumpers and frames. Hood must be able to open for inspection.
- 9) Chrome moldings, antenna, sun visors, and any other dangerous or loose objects must be removed and car must be clean of all debris before car enters fairgrounds.
- 10) Battery must be moved to the drivers compartment. Battery must be secured and covered.
- 11) Engine and transmission mounts may be chained or welded.
- 12) Fenders, bumpers, and grill may be cut. Bottom of rear seat must be removed
- 13) All cars must have working brakes to enter.
- 14) All cars must have a minimum 12" hole cut in hood above carburetor.
- 15) Radiators must remain in original position or taken out. No flammable fluids in cooling system.
- 16) Transmission coolers allowed but must be mounted in engine compartment
- 17) All doors must be securely fastened by chain or wire. Drivers door may be welded (max 2-6" tabs front edge, 2-6" tabs rear edge.
- 18) Drivers door to have original interior or other added padding. Driver's door may be reinforced. Reinforcing to be inside door and shall not extend beyond door jambs, Maximum 2 1/2" Tubing
- 19) No welds on hood, trunk, or tailgate or doors(except drivers door). Hoods may be removed.
- 20) Trunk lid may have a 12" inspection hole.
- 21) No trailer hitches or special bumpers or reinforcements allowed.
- 22) Absolutely no altering, welding or reinforcement of springs, frame, or other suspension components. All components must be stock or stock replacement.
- 23) No spring jacks, blocked shocks, or air shocks. Suspension must be free of all blocks
- 24) Front bumper shock tubes may be chained or welded to prevent them from pulling out.
- 25) Welding or chaining any parts to frame is prohibited (except engine and transmission).
- 26) A minimum 2 1/2 # ABC fire extinguisher within reach of driver and securely mounted Strongly Recommended
- 27) Tires must be DOT approved 4ply maximum. Rating must be visible. No double or liquid filled tires allowed. No tire studs or screws through rim to tire. Tires will be checked and marked at check in, any spare tires must be checked in with vehicle.
- 28) Throttle must have positive return springs.
- 29) Cars may be decorated in a good manner. **BOTH FRONT DOORS MUST BE PAINTED WHITE AND AN 18" X 18" AREA ON ROOF FOR NUMBERS THAT WILL BE ASSIGNED AT CHECK IN. NUMBERS WILL BE PAINTED ON CARS AS THEY ARE ENTERED.**
- 30) Car must have seat belt.

Any items removed from car during event are to be removed from grounds after event
